# Human Services VET in schools courses and jobs



## SCHOOL VET LEARNER TYPE

**Human Services VET courses** can be delivered at school or externally through TAFE or an RTO.

**School Based Traineeships (SBT):** student has paid employment to work one day a week though students can work extra through school holidays, weekends as negotiated with employer.

**Board Endorsed Courses (BEC):** counts towards HSC and includes unpaid mandatory work placement.

**Industry Curriculum Framework courses (ICF):** counts towards HSC and ATAR and includes unpaid mandatory work placement.

Students can choose a VET subject that may count towards their HSC and ATAR, get a Certificate II or III qualification (or Statement of Attainment), get real industry work experience and be ready for post school employment in Community Services and Health with a pathway to further study in VET or Uni.

### Board Endorsed Courses (HSC) & Industry Curriculum Frameworks (ATAR):

CIII in Individual Support (Ageing/Disability), CIII in Allied Health Assistance, CIII in Health Services Assistance.



## JOBS AND CAREER PATHWAYS

**Early Childhood Education and Care** - work in early childhood education settings supporting children's wellbeing, learning and development

**School Based Education Support** - work in education settings providing assistance and support to teachers and students

**Community Services** - provide person-centred care services in community settings or with community-based programs

**Individual Support (Age Care and Disability work)** - work in community or residential settings providing person-centred care and support

**Assistant roles** in Allied Health, Nursing, Patient Care Support, Health, Dental, Pharmacy Support.

## Community Services

### Community Services Jobs and Career start at school

- SBTs in Early Childhood Education and Care, School Based Education Support, Out of School Hours Care, Community Services, and Individual Support (Ageing/Disability)
- BECs or ICF course in Human Services – Individual Support (Ageing/Disability)
- Work in Early Childhood Education and Care, Family Day Care, Disability Support, Education Support, Out of School Hours Care, Youth Work, Sport and Recreation.
- Pathways to diplomas and other undergraduate and post graduate programs in Early childhood, School Aged Education and Care, Aged and Disability Care, Nursing, Allied Health, Health Science.

## Health Care

### Health Care Jobs and careers in start at school

- School-based traineeships in Health Support Services, Dental Assisting, Allied Health Assistance, Health Services Assistance and Hospital or Health Services Pharmacy Support
- BECs or ICF course in Human Services – Allied Health Assistance or Health Services Assistance.
- Post school pathways include some Certificate III entry level roles, traineeships and entry into higher qualifications.

**Allied Health Assistance** jobs in assistance roles in occupational therapy, nutrition, speech pathology, physiotherapy, ambulance or patient transfer.

**Health Service Assistant** jobs include Assistant in Nursing, patient care support, orderly, ward assistant, acute care assistant or operating theatre technician specialisations.

### Community Services

CIII Early Childhood Education and Care to Diploma of Early Childhood Education and Care to a Bachelor program (early childhood teacher).

CIII School Based Education Support to CIV School Based Education Support to Diploma of School Aged Education Support to a Bachelor program.

### Health Care

CIII Health Services Assistance to Diploma of Nursing (Enrolled Nurse) to Bachelor degree for Registered Nurse program.

CIII Hospital or Health Services Pharmacy Support pathway to CIV Hospital or Health Services Pharmacy Support to Bachelor of Pharmacy.
